A roll of barbed wire (15.5 Gauge, 4 points Barb 5" Spacing, 80 Rods (1,320'), 42lb, Zinc coating class 3)



5" Barb Spacing




Two barbs (4 points) removed



Four barb pairs removed (A barb consists of two short pins with 2 edges 30 degrees sliced reversely)

Side Wood Fence

 $6" \times 2"$ (Actual size is $5.5" \times 1.5"$) side wood fence top was a walking highway for squirrels. To prevent walking, I put a pair of $4 \times 35"$ barb wires on top as writing two Xs.




